


Licensed Marriage and Family Therapists

Per 100K Population, by Region, 2022




Licensed Clinical Social Workers

Per 100K Population, by Region, 2022




Licensed Psychologists

Per 100K Population, by Region, 2022




Licensed Psychiatrists*




Psychiatric Mental Health Registered Nurses


Per 100K Population, by Region, 2022



Per 100K Population, by Region, 2022





Per 100K Population, by Region, 2022




Associate Marriage and Family Therapists
